- UTEP opened its 107th season of football on Saturday.
- The Miners opened at a power conference opponent for the first time since the 2017 season.

BLUE BLAZE OFFENSE

- QB Skyler Locklear in his first collegiate start. Locklear completed his first five pass attempts for 59 yards and a score.
- For Locklear, it's his second career collegiate touchdown pass after throwing one last year while at Austin Peay.
- Locklear added a collegiate career-best 15 yards rushing, and tallied a career-long 11-yard rush in the third quarter.
- MB Kam Thomas scored his first FBS touchdown in the first quarter on a 38-yard reception.

ORANGE SWARM DEFENSE

• Senior LB **Dorian Hopkins**, a transfer from Tulsa, recovered a fumble in the second quarter. It was his first collegiate fumble recovery.

- Hopkins was credited with a collegiate career-high 16 tackles. His previous best was eight tackles in 2023 while at Tulsa.
- NT Sione Tonga'uiha recorded his first career full sack in the second quarter. He had .5 a sack versus NM State in 2023.
- Spur Kory Chapman tallied 10 tackles in his UTEP debut, making it his fifth double-digit effort in his collegiate career.
- S Landon Hullaby tallied his first career forced fumble and added three tackles in his UTEP debut.

WEFENSE

• P Adam Jacklin punted six times for 235 yards (39.2 avg.), including a long of 41 yards and one inside the 20.

• PR Kam Thomas returned a punt 29 yards.
